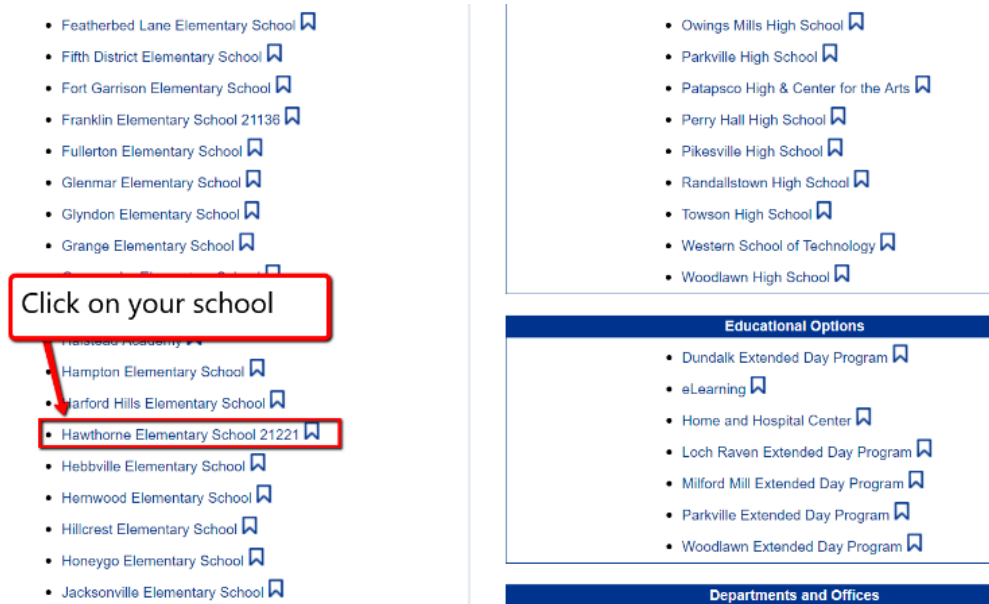


Finding/Assigning eBooks in Destiny

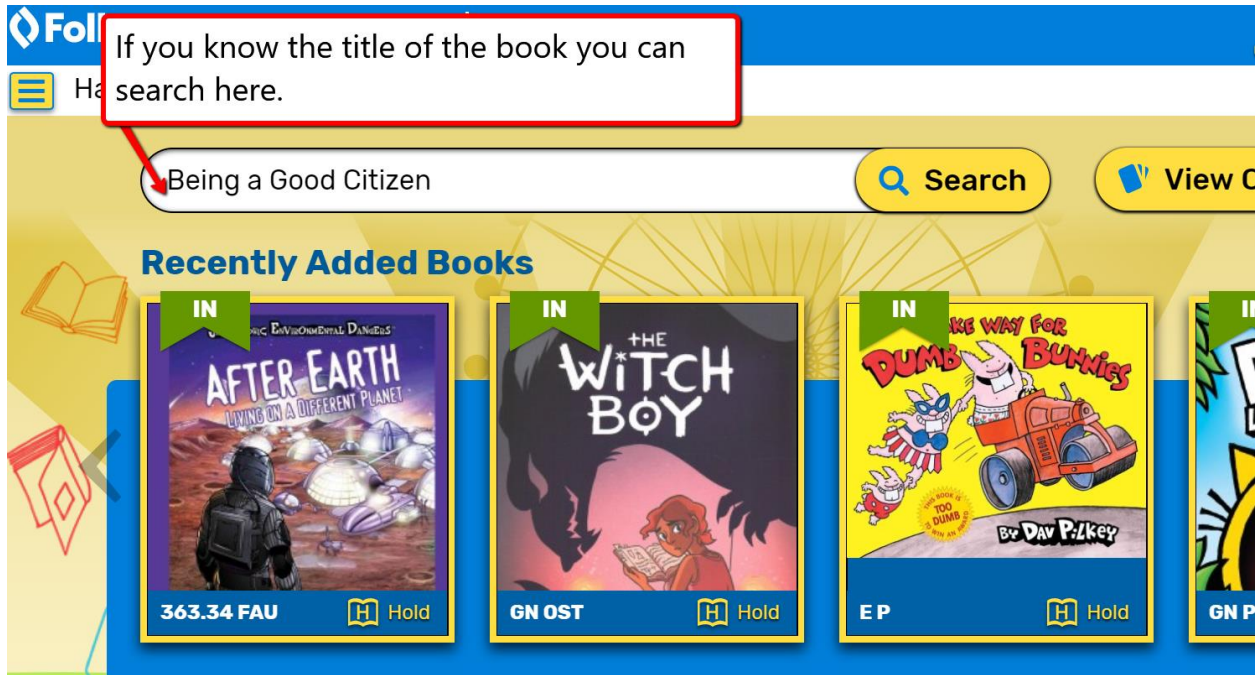
To get to the ebooks you need to log into the Destiny database which is located in the Digital Content.



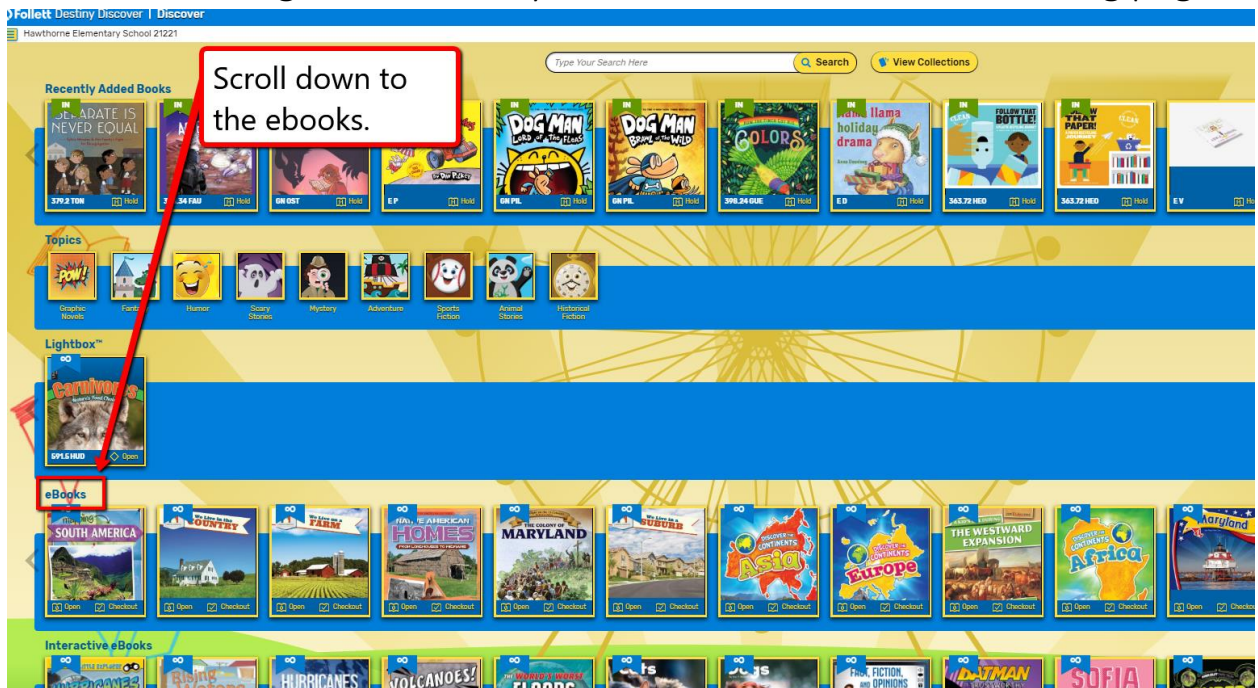
Then you need to select your school.



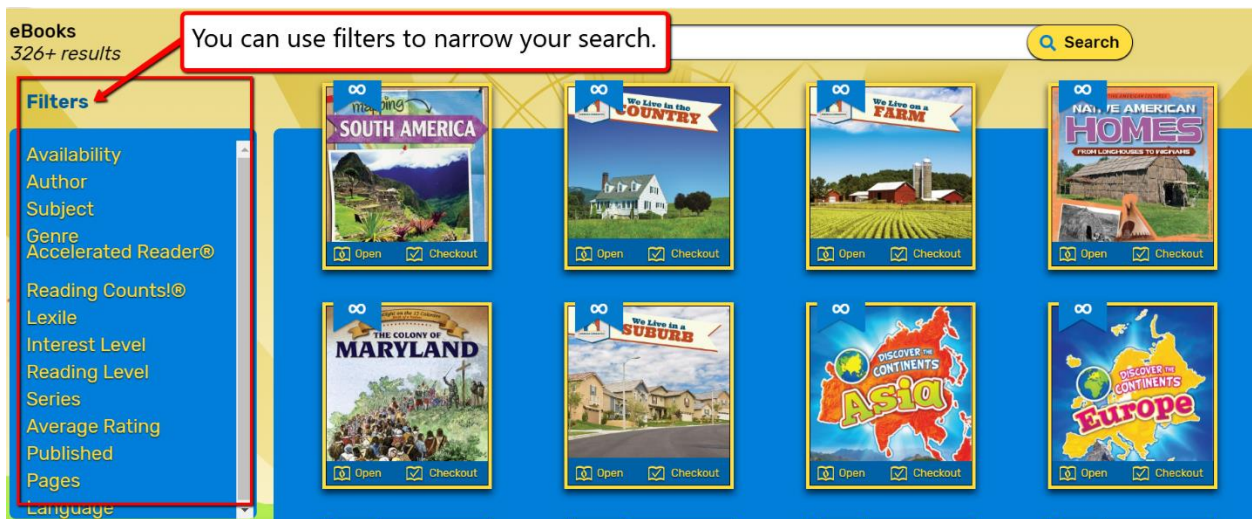
If you know the name of the book, follow the step below. If you do not skip this step and proceed to the next step.



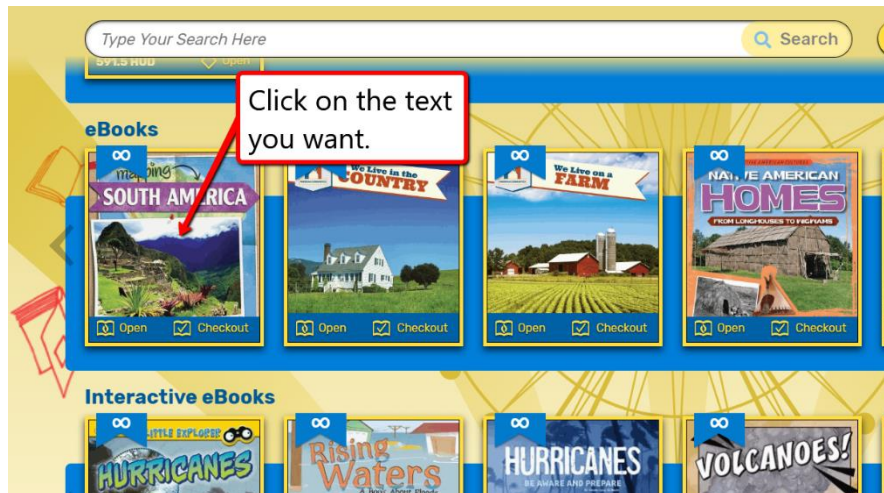
To search through the eBooks you will scroll down on the landing page.

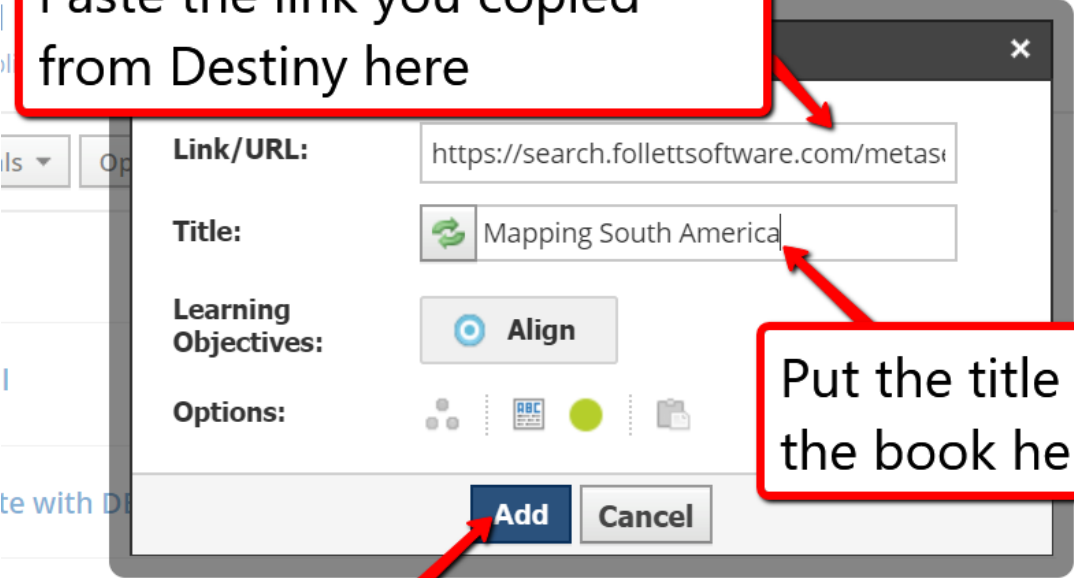
