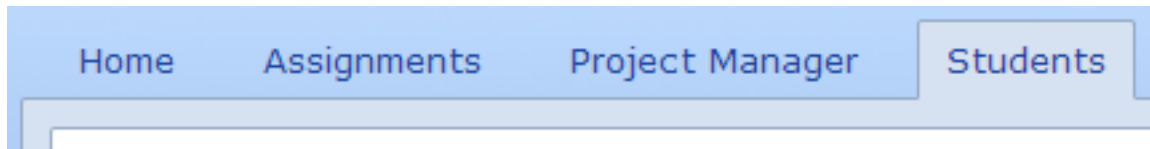


Click the Students tab.

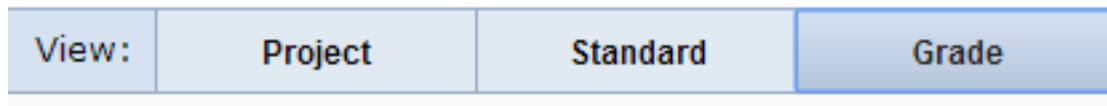


Click a student in the list.

Design	Title and author are clearly shown. Layout and use of colors, headings, and images make it easy to find and understand information. Does not use text sizes, color, layout, or images to help viewer find title, author, or information about content of story.
Content Summary	Summary includes information that describes character, setting, and plot. Interesting summary makes you want to read the entire book.	Summary includes information about character, setting, and plot. Write tells what happens.	Summary includes basic facts, but not interesting details. Missing information about key event(s) in plot.	Does not use color, font, style or size to help viewer find information.
